I am writing to express my strong interest in an internship position at Eurostat.

I am currently enrolled in a double degree programme in Political Sciences at the Catholic University of Eichstätt-Ingolstadt (KU) in Germany, in partnership with SciencesPo Rennes in France. As part of the requirements for this joint degree, I need to complete a mandatory internship of two months in a field related to politics or political science. A key element of the course pertains to the collection and analysis of data. I believe Eurostat would offer an exceptionally valuable experience.

The work carried out by Eurostat sits at the very intersection of data, governance, and European integration — all areas that are central to my academic studies. The prospect of gaining first-hand insight into how statistical data is collected, harmonised, and communicated across EU member states is something I find both intellectually stimulating and professionally compelling.

Understanding the role that reliable data plays in shaping EU policy is, in my view, an essential dimension of a well-rounded political science education.


